No.	Question	Answer
1	Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, can the deadline be extended by 1 week?	Yes.
2	Is this the initial RFP for all DME product categories?	Yes – any and all products that the vendor has to offer.
3	What DME products and services are included in this scope?	See answer to #2.
4	Can you describe the goals for this RFP?	To contract with any DME vendor who meets UK needs for this line.
5	Is Negative Pressure a part of the category scope?	See answer #2.
6	What areas of UK Healthcare is supported? Acute, Physician Clinics, ASC? Any additional?	All outpatient DME service touchpoints (this includes all UKHC clinics, outpatient surgery areas, and UKHC Hospital discharge patients). UKHC does not currently have Long Term Health Care Facility.
7	Is there an estimated number of locations identified for supporting products and services?	We currently have 1 UK DME store front with more coming in the future, and 8 retail pharmacy locations that can support dispensing DME products, along with other supply closets embedded inside various UKHC Clinics, and eventually the Emergency Departments.

8	Are automated solutions required to support product and service needs?	Not necessarily – we use automation when we can, but is not necessarily a requirement unless required by applicable regulatory body.
9	What requirements are necessary to meet automated solution requirements?	All automated solutions are required to undergo an IT Security Assessment, and integration teams may be required to scope the project depending on the size and complexity.
