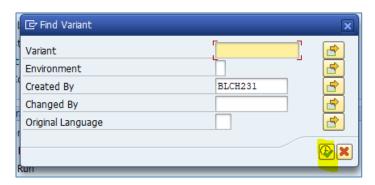
How to fix errors on requisitions during MRP runs; these are sometimes called "red bombs".

**Requisitions can "red bomb" when running the queue for multiple reasons, most often for sourcing issues (info record, contract, pricing, etc.) but also for order requirements

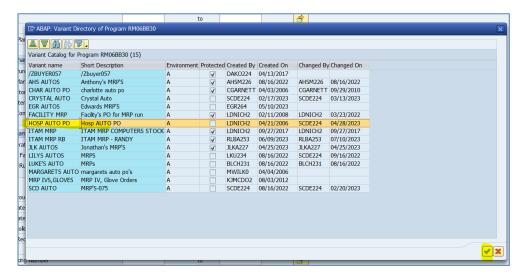
**Involve the Strategic Sourcing Specialist as needed

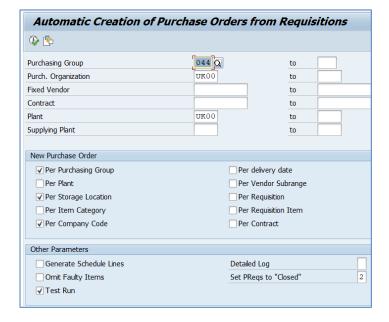
- Go into ME59N to run the auto queue
- Click the "Variant" icon, remove text in "created by" field, Click the "Execute" icon



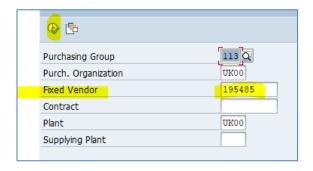


 Choose "Hosp Auto PO" by double clicking the line or by selecting the line and clicking the check





If for any reason a vendor auto-filled, erase it and then Click "Execute"

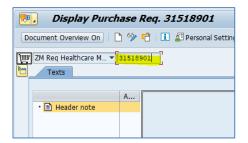


**The below requisition has bombed and will not convert for some reason

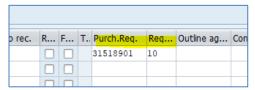
• Double-click the requisition to go into it



Copy the requisition and go into transaction ME21N (Create Purchase Order)



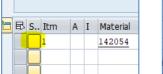
• Slide to the right and enter the requisition, press enter to populate other information **If MRP requisition, line number is ALWAYS 10, If Manual requisition, line number will be specific

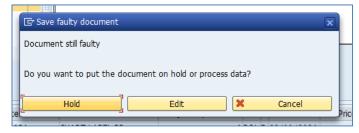
How Fix Requisition Errors During MRP Run

- **If it is a sourcing issue, the line will bomb with a red stop sign, click the stop sign for more info
 - This order did not automatically bomb so I am going to proceed as normal and click save

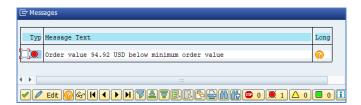




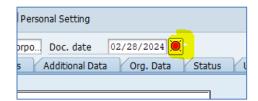
**A pop-up appeared with 3 options: Hold, Edit, Cancel

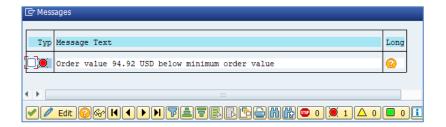


- **Hold will convert the requisition to a PO but will keep it internal, there is no output to the supplier, **DON'T DO THIS**
- **Edit will allow the bomb pop-up to appear with what is stopping the order

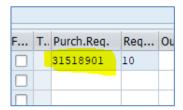


- **Cancel will bring you back to the PO but will show the bomb stop sign up by the document date
- **You can click this emblem to display the bomb pop-up as well

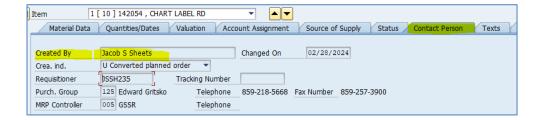




- **This is an order requirement message stating our PO is below threshold that allows us to avoid extra fees from the supplier
 - Double-click the requisition to see who you should contact via email about the issue
