1	For Work Scope Items designated as Vendor, please confirm that pertains to Contractors scope of work within the contract?	Vendor refers to the Owners PET-CT Vendor, not the Contractor
2	Please confirm UKIT will be responsible for Communications/Data scope of work, and we are not to include in bid?	UK IT will be disconnecting and reconnecting the trailer
3	Other than electrical permit, will any other permits be required? And will the Contractor be responsible for obtaining?	The mobile CT vendor will disconnect and reconnect the trailer to electrical. No electrical permit should be needed unless the work requires electrical demolition and reinstallation of the enclosed walkway.
4	To confirm, all work associated with this project is to occur on Weekends?	The replacement of the trailer with the new is to occur over a single weekend (not weekends). This needs to be coordinated and planned by the GC to include disconnect with Owner's team and with Owner's vendor who provides the Mobile Pet/CT trailer and removes the existing trailer.
5	The drawings indicate to Lift and Place Existing Trailer on site designated by Owner. Can you clarify/confirm where this is to be located? Also, please confirm the Contractor is not responsible for the Existing Trailer beyond placement at this designated location?	We cannot confirm the locations where the existing trailer will be set for removal, nor can we confirm at this time where the new tractor trailer will be. This will need to be coordinated by your team and the Owner. The contractor is responsible for moving the existing trailer from it's current position and placing the new trailer in the same position. The contractor is responsible for damage to either trailer resulting from the work.
6	Who will be responsible for the installation of the Trailer Stairs & Lift?	The vendor supplying the PET-CT trailer will install the stairs and lift.
7	Are we to include any scope for Water or Sewer connections?	No
